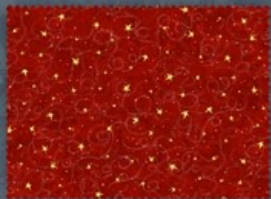

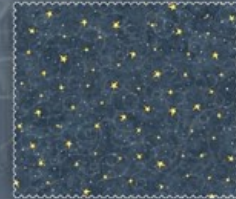

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Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## 1. Cut the following:

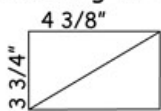
**Fabric A** - cut 8 - 9 1/2" X 11 1/2"\*\*\* (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut identical borders lengthwise - cut 2 - 6" x 62 1/2" (SIDES) and cut 2 - 6" x 52 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

**Fabric D** - cut 4 - 3 1/2" strips

cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 26 - 3 1/2" x 3" rectangles

cut 3 - 4 3/8" strips, subcut 26 - 4 3/8" x 3 3/4" rectangles. Stack rectangles right sides up and cut in half diagonally according to the diagram:



**Fabric E** - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 26 - 3 1/2" x 3" rectangles

cut 3 - 4 3/8" strips, subcut 26 - 4 3/8" x 3 3/4" rectangles. (Cut in half diagonally same as D)

**Fabric F** - cut 4 - 3 1/2" strips

Inner Border - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

BINDING - cut 7 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

**Fabric G** - cut 2 - 6 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 6 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles

cut 1 - 3 1/4" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/4" squares

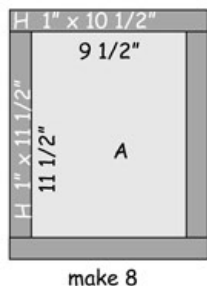
**Fabric H** - cut 2 - 6 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 6 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles

cut 1 - 3 1/4" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/4" squares

\*\*cut 12 - 1" strips, subcut 16 - 1" x 11 1/2" (SIDES) and 16 - 1" x 10 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

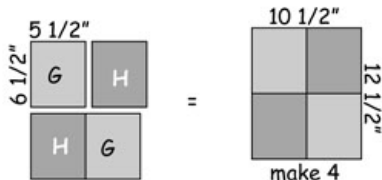
## 2. Piecing order:

1. Sew H borders around A blocks, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. \*\* (If A measurements are slightly different, cut H borders slightly larger, sew around A blocks then trim blocks to measure 10 1/2" x 12 1/2".) Make 8.



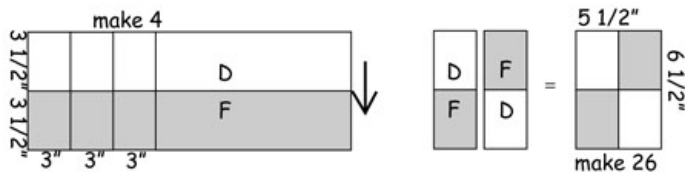

2. Sew G and H 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles together for four 4-patches - 10" x 12" finished (10 1/2" x 12 1/2" unf.)



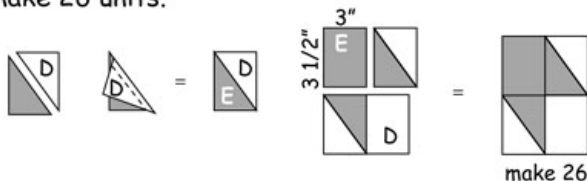

3. Sew 4 pairs of D and F 3 1/2" strips. Press toward F. Subcut 52 - 3" segments. Then sew segments together for 26 - 4 patches, 5" x 6" finished (5 1/2" x 6 1/2" unf.)



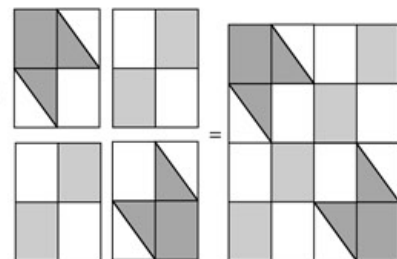

4. Sew D and E triangles together for 52 units, 2 1/2" x 3" finished (3" x 3 1/2" unf.) Press toward E triangles. Then add D and E 3" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Make 26 units.



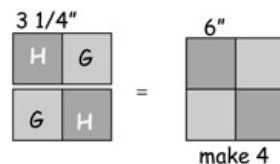

5. Sew units from step 3 and step 4 together for 13 - 10" x 12" finished (10 1/2" x 12 1/2" unf.) blocks.

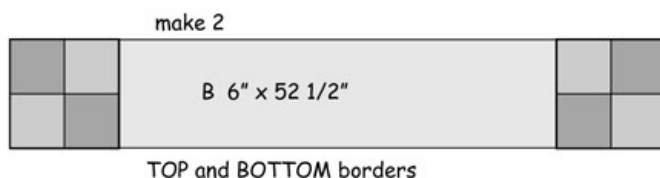

6. Make four Corner 4-Patches by sewing G and H 3 1/4" squares together, 5 1/2" finished (6" unf.). Sew a 4-patch to each end of both TOP and BOTTOM (B) borders, pay attention to the direction of the stripe and placement of 4-patches according to the diagram.

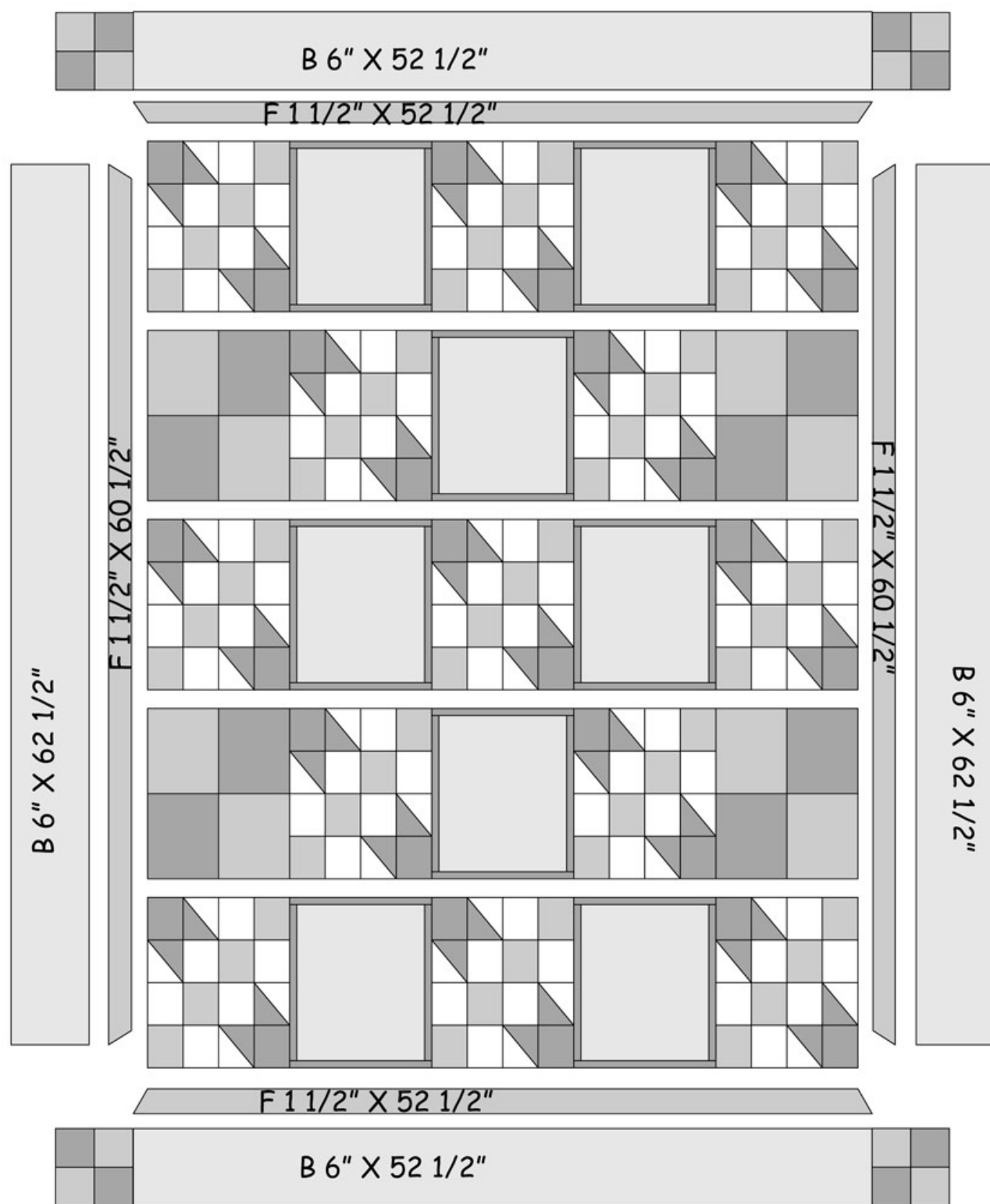

7. Sew quilt together by rows, alternating blocks according to the diagram. Next, sew Inner Border (F), SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. Last, sew outer border (B) to the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



8. The quilt measures approximately  $63'' \times 73''$ . Make backing (Fabric C) at least  $6''$  larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (F) and enjoy!!
