# Bedtime Stories Flannel

Finished Quilt- 56" x 72"

## Yardage:

### Panel Squares:

2/3 yard of F10041-1

### Border Two:

1-3/4 yards of F10042-1

### Large Heart Backgrounds:

1/2 yard of F10049-1

### Block Sashing & Outer Border:

2 yards of F10048-1

### Block Frames, Border One Blocks & Binding:

1-1/4 yards of F10050-4

### Large Hearts & Border One Blocks:

1/3 yard of F10044-1 and F10045-1

### Large Hearts, Small Hearts & Border One Blocks:

1/2 yard of F10050-1

### Border One Blocks:

1/4 yard of F10043-1, F10046-1, F10047-1, F10050-3 and F10050-5

### Border One Blocks and Small Heart Backgrounds :

1/3 yard of F10050-2

### Fusible Web:

1 yard of fusible web

## Cutting:

### Panel Squares:

Fussy cut nine 6-1/2" squares.

### Border Two:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" and two 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips from the length of fabric.

### Large Heart Backgrounds:

Cut six 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.

### Block Sashing & Outer Border:

Cut twenty 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips, six 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips. Cut six 4-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece them together into two 4-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips and two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips.

### Block Frames, Border One Blocks & Binding:

Cut five 4-1/2" squares, eighteen 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips, eighteen 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and seven 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Piece them together for the binding.

### Large Hearts & Border One Blocks:

From each fabric, cut five 4-1/2" squares. See applique directions and cut two large hearts.

### Large Hearts, Small Hearts & Border One Blocks:

Cut five 4-1/2" squares. See applique directions and cut two large hearts and four small hearts.

### Border One Blocks:

From each fabric, cut five 4-1/2" squares.

### Border One Blocks and Small Heart Backgrounds :

Cut nine 4-1/2" squares.

## Directions:

- 1) Sew one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" F10050-4 strip to each side of the panel squares. Sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip onto the top and bottom of each panel square.
- 2) Following the manufacturer's instructions on the fusible web, trace six large hearts and four small hearts onto the paper side of the fusible web (or use your favorite applique method).
- 3) Roughly cut out each shape and iron it to the back of the appropriate fabric as listed in the cutting directions. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
- 3) Fuse each of the large hearts onto one 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" F10049-1 piece. Fuse each of the small hearts onto one 4-1/2" F10050-2 squares. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a blanket or satin stitch.
- 4) To make the rows, follow the quilt photo for placement and sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" block sashing in between each of the panel blocks. There are three blocks across in each row. Sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" block sashing on each end of the rows. Make three rows total.
- 5) Repeat Step 4 with the heart blocks and the 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" block sashing strips. Make two rows.
- 6) Following the quilt layout, sew the rows and 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" horizontal block sashing strips together.
- 7) For the border one sides, sew together twelve of the 4-1/2" squares from the assorted fabrics for each side. For the border one top and bottom, sew together ten of the 4-1/2" squares from the assorted fabrics for each. You will have six squares left over.
- 8) Following the quilt layout, add the borders to the quilt.
- 9) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
