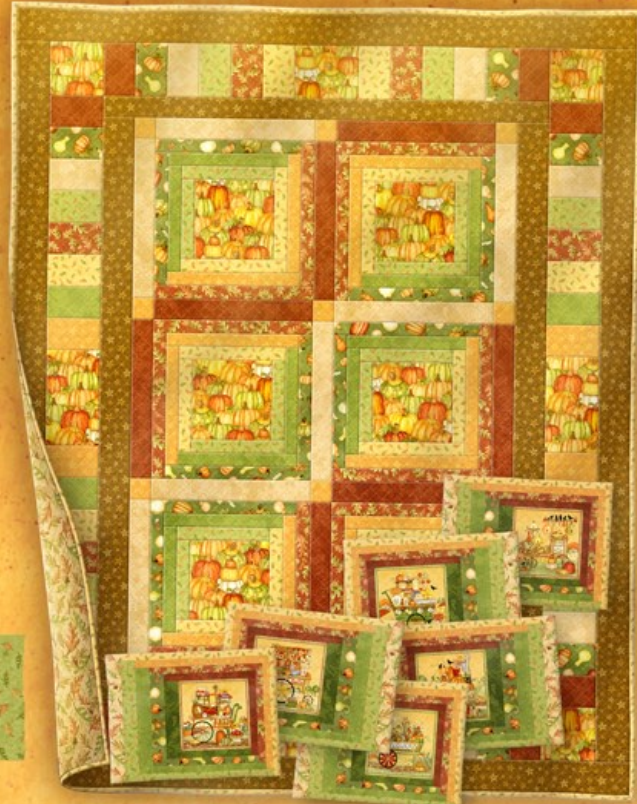

HARVEST MARKET

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Quilt Instructions approximate size 59" x 74"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 1 - 9 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 9 1/2" x 5 1/2"
(Side borders)

cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 5 1/2" squares (corners)

and 2 - 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Top and Bottom borders)

cut 1 - 8" strip, also use remaining 9 1/2" strip and subcut
6 - 8" x 8" squares (centers)

Fabric B - cut 5 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 13" and
6 - 1 3/4" x 14 1/4"

cut 1 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric C - Inner Border - cut 3 - 3 1/2" strips, sew end to
end and subcut 2 - 3 1/2" x 53 1/2" (Sides)

cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end and subcut

2 - 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Outer Border - cut 7 - 3 1/2" strips, sew end to end for
1 long strip then subcut 2 - 3 1/2" x 67 1/2" (Sides) and

2 - 3 1/2" x 58 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric D - cut 4 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 11 3/4"
and 6 - 1 3/4" x 13"

cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 12 - 2 1/2" squares (cornerstones)

cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric F - cut 6 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 14 1/4"
and 6 - 1 3/4" x 15 1/2"

cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric G - cut 5 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 9 1/4"
and 6 - 1 3/4" x 10 1/2"

cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

BINDING - cut 7 - 2 1/4" strips end to end and press in
half

Fabric H - cut 4 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 8" and
6 - 1 3/4" x 9 1/4"

cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric I - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 9 - 2 1/2" x 15 1/2"
(Sashing)

cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric J - cut 4 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 3/4" x 10 1/2"
and 6 - 1 3/4" x 11 3/4"

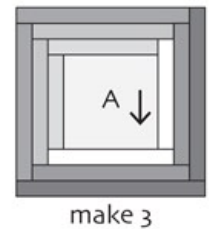
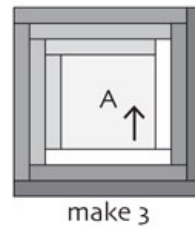
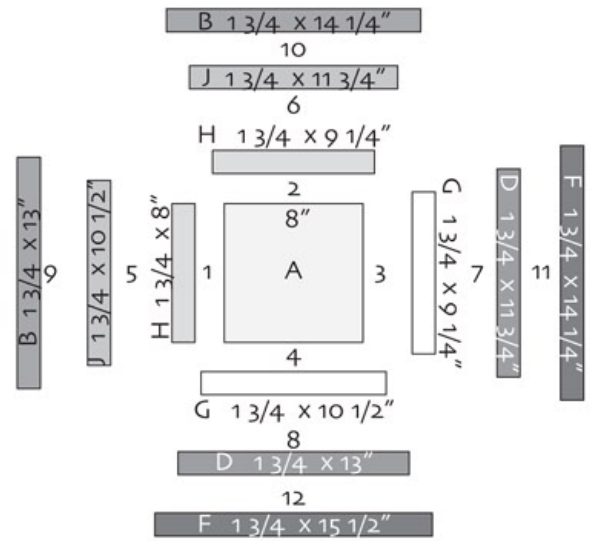
cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

Fabric K - cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 2 1/2" x 15 1/2"
(Sashing)

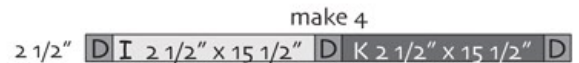
cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)

2. Piecing Order:

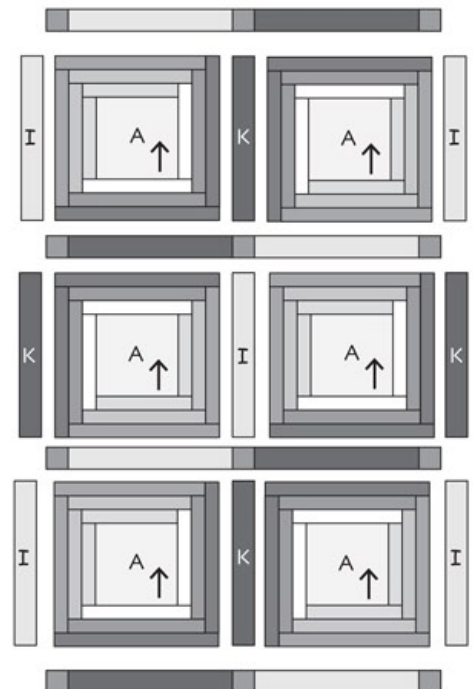
1. Make 6 - 15" finished (15 1/2" unf.) Log Cabin Blocks. Sew individual logs around center square **A** according to the numbered diagram. Press each log away from the center square before adding the next log. ****Fabric A** is directional so half (3) of the blocks will begin with **A** facing up and the other half (3) blocks will begin with **A** facing down according to the arrows in the diagram.



2. Sew 4 rows of sashing strips (**I** and **K**) and cornerstones (**D**) according to the diagram:



3. Sew Log Cabin Blocks and **I** or **K** sashing strips together by rows according to the diagram. Next, sew rows of blocks and rows of sashing strips together for the quilt center according to the diagram.



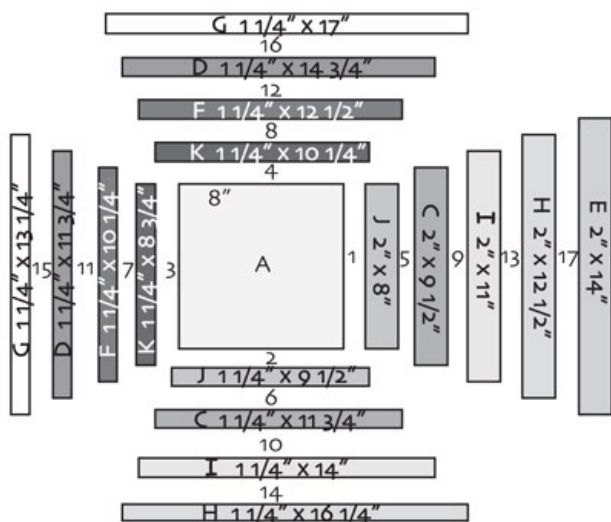
Set of (6) Placemat Instructions: approximate size 13 1/2" x 18" each

1. Cut the following:

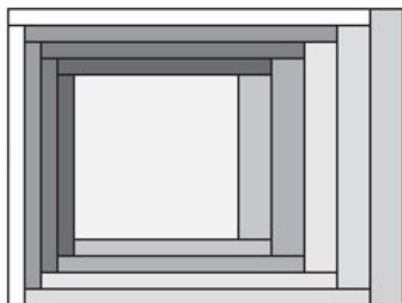
- Fabric A** - cut 6 - 8" x 8" squares (center designs evenly)
- Fabric B** - BACKING - cut 6 - 14" x 18 1/2"
- Fabric C** - cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 6 - 2" x 9 1/2"
cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 11 3/4"
- Fabric D** - cut 5 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 14 3/4" and
6 - 1 1/4" x 11 3/4"
- Fabric E** - cut 3 - 2" strips, subcut 6 - 2" x 14"
- Fabric F** - cut 4 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 12 1/2"
and 6 - 1 1/4" x 10 1/4"
- Fabric G** - cut 5 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 17"
and 6 - 1 1/4" x 13 1/4"
- Fabric H** - cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 6 - 2" x 12 1/2"
cut 3 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 16 1/4"
- Fabric I** - cut 3 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 14"
cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 6 - 2" x 11"
- Fabric J** - cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 9 1/2"
cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 6 - 2" x 8"
- Fabric K** - cut 4 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/4" x 8 3/4"
and 6 - 1 1/4" x 10 1/4"
- Thin Batting - cut 6 - 14" x 18 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

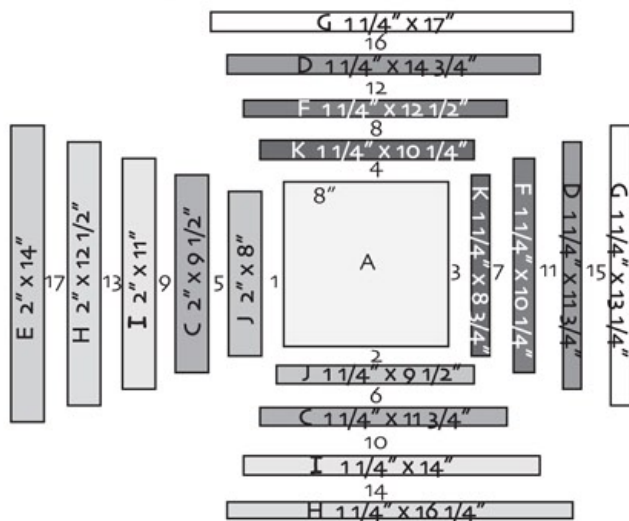
1. Make 3 placemats by sewing individual logs around center square **A** according to the numbered diagram (clockwise). Press each log away from the center square before adding the next log.



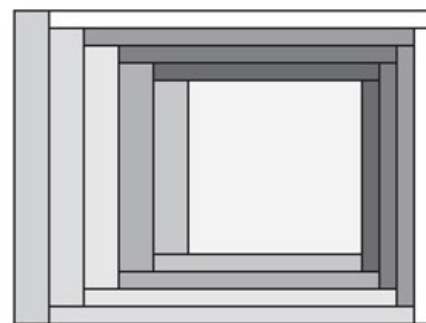

2. Make 3 placemats by sewing logs around center square **A** according to the numbered diagram (counter clockwise). Press each log away from the center square before add the next log.

3. Layer batting, placemat (right side up) and backing (right side down). Match raw edges and pin layers together.

Stitch 1/4" around edge of placemat and leave approximately 8" opening along middle of bottom edge for turning. Clip corners and turn placemats right sides out. Press and stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired. Repeat for all 6 placemats. Enjoy!!
