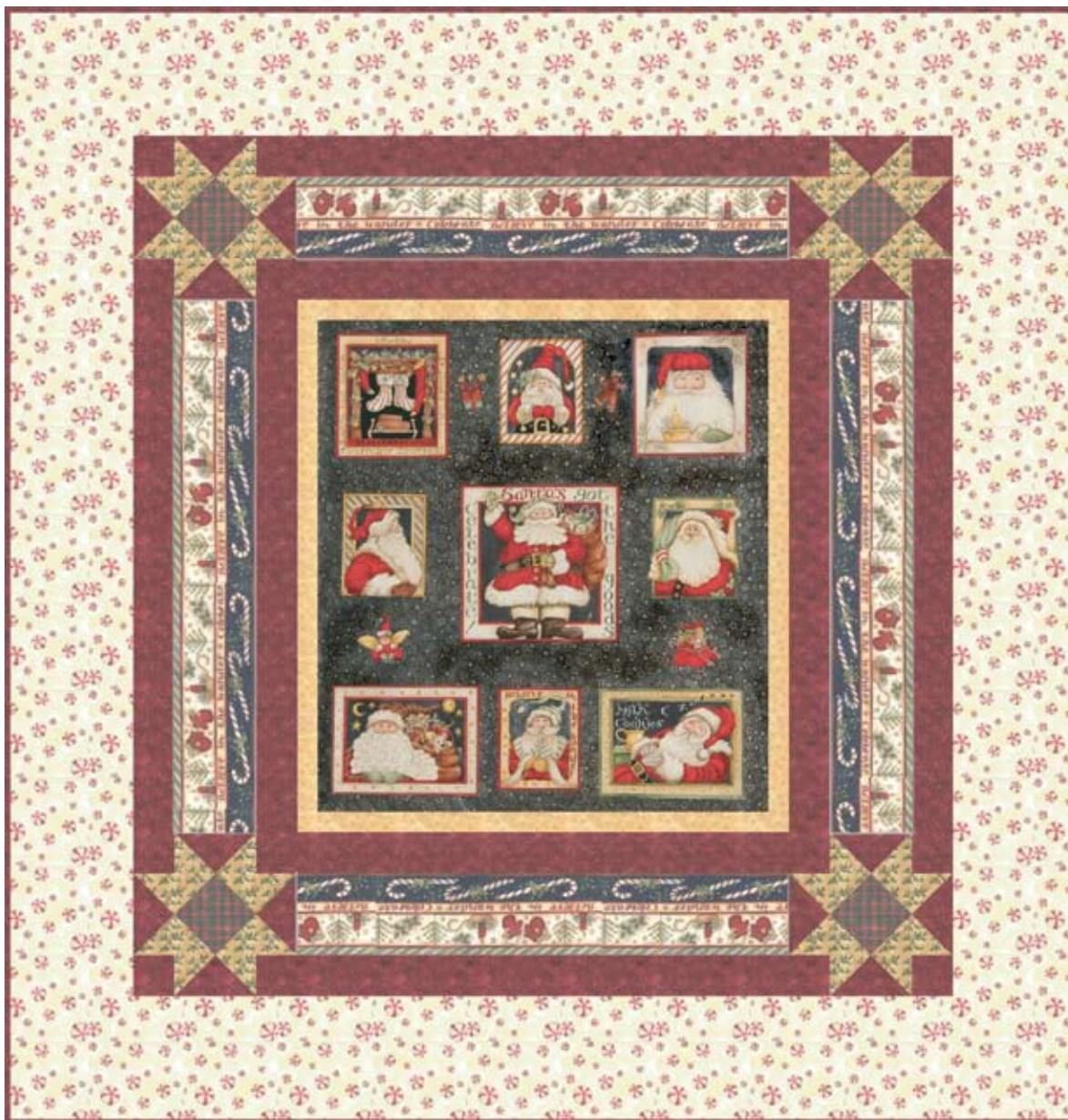


Santa's Got the Goods

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 - Panel (10120-1M)
- 1 Yard - Pictorial Stripe (10121-1M)
- 1/4 Yard - Gold Holly (10123-2M)
- 1 1/4 Yards - Cream Peppermints (10124-2)
- 1/4 Yard - Red Plaid (10126-3)
- 1/2 Yard - Blue Stars (10127-1M)
- 1/4 Yard - Gold Stars (10127-2M)
- 3/4 Yard - Red Stars (10127-3M)
- 1/2 Yard - Binding Red Stars
- 3 1/4 Yards - Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Pictorial Stripe fussy cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x LOF strips of the candy canes, mittens, trees and candles section as show on our layout; cut into:
 - 2 - 4 1/2" x 26 1/2" rectangles
 - 2 - 4 1/2" x 24 1/2" rectangles

From the Gold Holly cut:

- 3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips cut into:
 - 48 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Cream Peppermints cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips pieced and cut into:
 - 2 - 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" rectangles
 - 2 - 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangles

From the Red Plaid cut:

- 4 - 4 1/2" squares

From the Blue Stars cut:

- 4 - 3 1/2" x WOF strips

From the Gold Stars cut:

- 4 - 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" rectangles

From the Red Stars cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" rectangles
- 16 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- 16 - 2 1/2" squares

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. Clothworks is not responsible for printing errors.

Directions

Assemble the Quilt Center

1. Trim the Santa's Got the Goods panel to approximately 21 1/2" x 23 1/2". *Note: Because the panel measurement may vary, the next step in the instructions will add a larger border that will be trimmed to the necessary finished size.*
2. Sew a 3 1/2" x WOF Blue Stars strip to each long edge of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each strip flush with the top and bottom edges of the panel. (Fig. 1).
3. Sew a 3 1/2" x WOF Blue Stars strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each strip flush with the left and right edges of the panel.
4. Trim the panel, with borders added, to measure 22 1/2" x 24 1/2".
5. Sew a 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Gold Stars rectangle to each long edge of the panel; press away from the panel. Sew a 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the center.

Assemble the Star Blocks

1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the forty-eight 2 1/2" Gold Holly squares.
2. Place 2 1/2" Gold Stars square on the corner of a 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Red Plaid square (Fig 2). Sew along the drawn line and trim corner 1/4" from the stitching line; press toward the corner (Fig.3). Repeat on the remaining three corners as shown (Fig. 4). Repeat this step with each of the 4 1/2" Red Plaid squares to make a total of four center units.

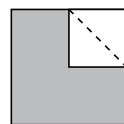

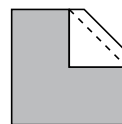

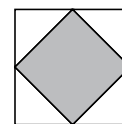

3. Place a 2 1/2" Gold Holly square to one end of a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Red Stars rectangle (Fig. 5). Sew along the drawn line and trim corner 1/4" from the stitching line (Fig. 6) and press toward the corner (Fig. 7). Repeat this process on the opposite end of the same rectangle as shown (Fig. 8). Repeat for a total of sixteen flying geese units (Fig. 9).

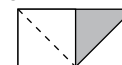

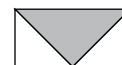

4. Layout four flying geese units, four center units and four 2 1/2" Red Star squares (Fig. 10). Join the pieces in each row, pressing the seams away from the flying geese units. Sew the rows together and press away from the center to complete the star block. The finished star block should measure 8 1/2" square including seam allowances.

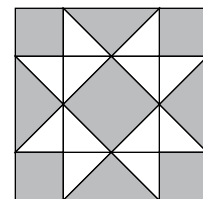

Assemble the Quilt

1. Sew a 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" red rectangle to each side of a 4 1/2" x 26 1/2" pictorial stripe rectangle and press. Repeat for a total of two units. Sew these units to the long edges of the quilt center. Press away from the center.
2. Sew a 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" Red Stars rectangle to each side of a 4 1/2" x 24 1/2" pictorial stripe rectangle and press. Repeat to make a total of two units. Sew a star block to each end of these units; press away from the star block. Sew these units to the top and bottom edges of the quilt; press away from the center.
3. Sew a 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" Cream Peppermints rectangle to the long edges of the quilt top; press away from the center. Sew a 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" Cream Peppermints rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top; press away from the center.
