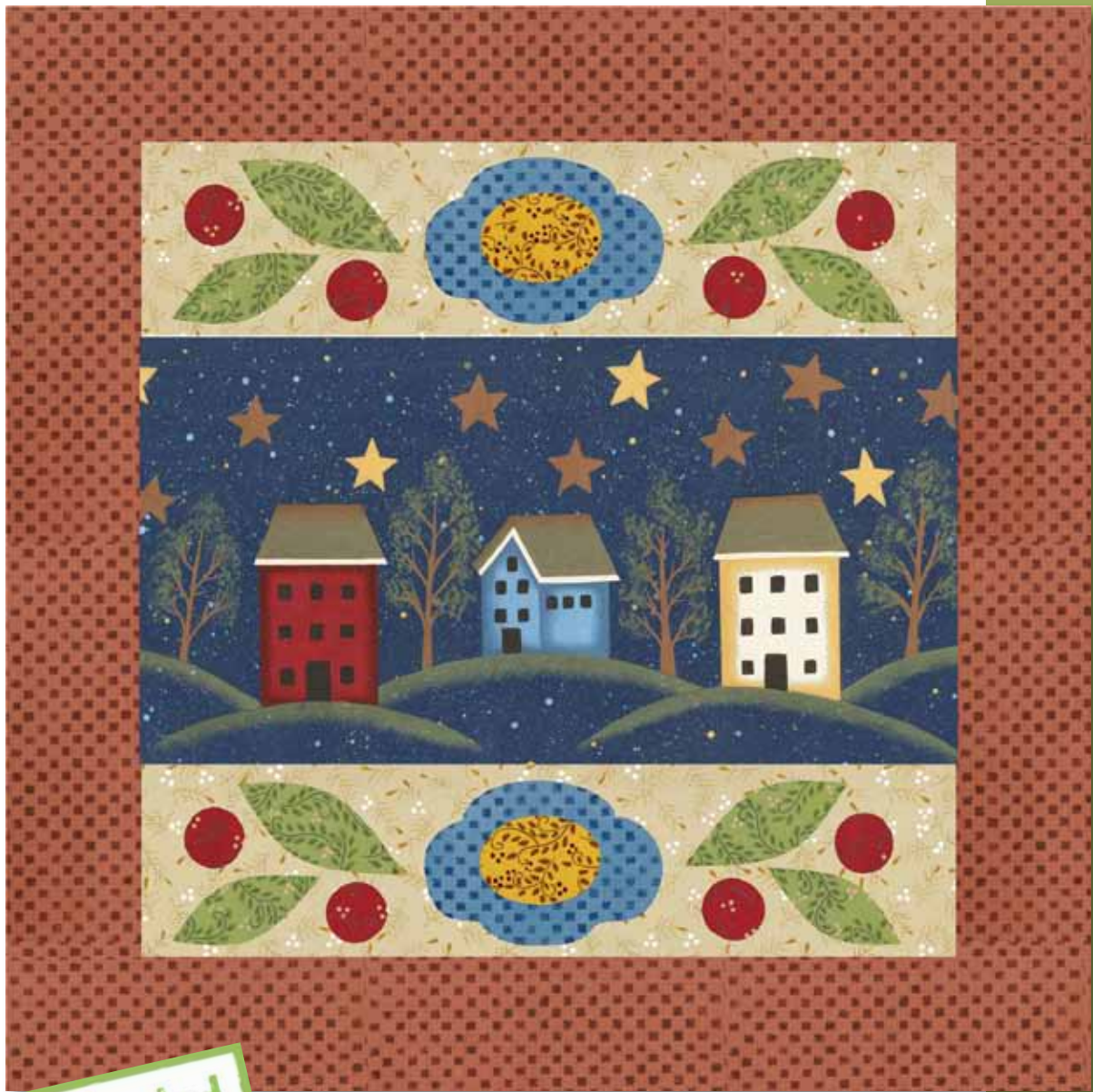


# Welcome Home

## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1/3 yd of Navy Houses (Y0192-31)
- 1/8 yd Tan Branches (Y0195-2)
- 1/2 yd Red Check (Y0193-51)
- border and backing
- 1/8 yd or 1-5" square Blue Check (Y0193-30)
- 1/8 yd or 1-5" square Green Vine (Y0194-25)
- 1/8 yd or 1-5" square Red Branch (Y0195-4)
- 1/8 yd or 1-3" square Gold Vine (Y0194-14)
- 1 - 14" pillow form
- 1/4 yard Fusible web transfer

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Navy Houses cut:

1 - 11" long x 6" wide rectangle as shown in picture

### From the Tan branches cut:

2 - 3" x 11" rectangles

### From the Red check cut:

2 - 10" x 14-1/2" rectangles

2 - 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" rectangles

2 - 2-1/4" x 11" rectangles

### From the Blue check prepare fusible shapes:

2 - flowers

### From the Green vine prepare fusible shapes:

4 - large leaves

4 - small leaves

### From the Red branch prepare fusible shapes:

8 - berries

### From the Gold vine prepare fusible shapes:

2 - flower centers

### Making the Pillow Top

1. Sew a 3" x 11" tan branch rectangle to the top and bottom sides of the navy house 6" x 11" center as shown in Figure 1. Press the seams towards the dark fabric.
2. Sew a red check 2-1/4" x 11" border strip to the left and right sides of the pillow center as shown in Figure 2. Press the seams outward.
3. Sew a red check 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" border strip to the top and bottom sides of the pillow center as shown in Figure 3. Press the seams outward.
4. Fuse the flowers, leaves and berries to the top and bottom tan branch rectangles as shown in the picture. Finish the appliqué edges with a narrow zigzag stitch in matching colors. Press the pillow top facedown on a towel to remove sewing distortion. The top should measure 14-1/2" square.

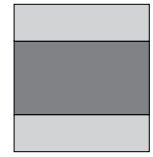

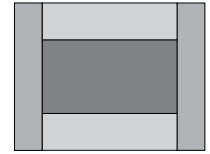

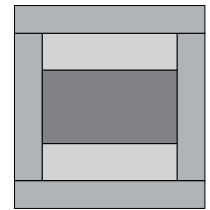

### Making the Back and Finishing the Pillow

1. Turn over to the back side and sew a double 1/4" hem along one 14-1/2" side of the two backing red check 10" x 14-1/2" pieces as shown in Figure 4.
2. Lay right sides together the prepared back pieces on top of the pillow top as shown in Figure 5. The hemmed sides of the backing pieces should be in the center so that the pillow has a finished opening in the center back to insert and remove the pillow form.
3. Pin the two layers together all around the sides and sew together. Turn inside out and insert the pillow form through the finished opening. If desired, push extra batting into the corners inside to fill out the pillow shape.
