

Sprucing Up the Neighborhood

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:


- Fabric A cut 1 23 1/2" x 28" (center design evenly)
- Fabric B cut 2 identical stripes 7 1/4" x 33"
- Fabric C cut 3 8 1/2" strips, subcut 6 7" x 8 1/2"
- (TOP and BOTTOM) and subcut 8 6 3/8" x 8 1/2" (SIDES)
- Fabric D cut 7 2" strips, then subcut 2 2" x 33" (TOP and BOTTOM) and 2 2" x 36" (TOP and BOTTOM)
- Sew the remaining 3 strips end to end and subcut 2 $2" \times 45"$ (SIDES)
- Fabric E (a) cut 2 4 7/8" strips, subcut 14 4 7/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 28
- triangles \(\subseteq \)

 (b) cut 2 2 3/8" strips, subcut 28 -2 3/8" squares **Fabric F** cut 4 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 1 1/2" x


 26 1/2" (STDFS) and 2 1 1/2" x 33" (TOP and
- 26 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 1 1/2" \times 33" (TOP and BOTTOM)
- **Fabric G** (a) cut 2 4 7/8" strips, subcut 14 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 28 triangles \square
- (b) cut 2 2 3/8" strips, subcut 28 2 3/8" squares Fabric H - cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 2 - 2" x 23 1/2"
- (SIDES) and 2 2" × 31" (TOP and BOTTOM)
- BINDING cut 6 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half
- Fabric I (c) cut 3 3 7/8" strips, subcut 28 3 7/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 112 triangles ⊠
- (d) cut 2 2 1/4" strips, subcut 28 2 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 56 triangles \square

2. Piecing order:

1. Make 14 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) pieced blocks. First, make 28 - 4" f. RED (Fabric E) and 28 - GREEN (Fabric G) blocks according to the diagram. Then sew smaller blocks together by rows for the larger blocks.



- 2. Sew individual borders **H** and **F** around center panel **A**, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.
- 3. Next, sew D 2" \times 33" and B 7 1/4" \times 33" above and below center block.
- 4. Sew **D** borders around center block, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.
- 4. Sew three Pieced Blocks alternating four (\mathcal{C}) 6 3/8" x 8 1/2" rectangles for each SIDE border. Sew four Pieced blocks alternating three (\mathcal{C}) 7" x 8 1/2" rectangles for the TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew SIDE borders to the quilt center first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders acording to the diagram.



6. The quilt measures approximately 52 1/2" x 64 1/2". Make backing (Fabric E) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (H) and enjoy!!
