

## Sprucing Up the Neighiborhood

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A-cut 1-231/2" $\times 28^{\prime \prime}$ (center design evenly) Fabric B - cut 2 identical stripes $71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric $C$ - cut $3-81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $6-7^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM) and subcut $8-63 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (SIDES)
Fabric D - cut 7-2" strips, then subcut $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM) and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM)
Sew the remaining 3 strips end to end and subcut 2 $2^{\prime \prime} \times 45^{\prime \prime}$ (SIDES)
Fabric E - (a) cut 2-47/8" strips, subcut 14-47/8" squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 28 triangles $\square$
(b) cut $2-23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $28-23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares Fabric F-cut 4-11/2" strips, subcut 2-11/2" $\times$ 26 1/2" (SIDES) and 2-11/2" $\times 33^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM)
Fabric 6 - (a) cut 2-47/8" strips, subcut 14-47/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 28 triangles $\square$
(b) cut $2-23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $28-23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares Fabric H-cut $4-2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (SIDES) and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM)
BINDING - cut 6-2 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew end to end and press in half
Fabric I - (c) cut 3-37/8" strips, subcut $28-37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 112 triangles $\boxtimes$
(d) cut $2-21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $28-21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut squares in half diagonally for 56 triangles $\square$
2. Piecing order:

1. Make $14-8^{\prime \prime}$ finished ( $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unf.) pieced blocks. First, make 28-4" f. RED (Fabric E) and 28-GREEN (Fabric $G$ ) blocks according to the diagram. Then sew smaller blocks together by rows for the larger blocks.

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
