Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Prepare **TEMPLATES 1 - 6** by tracing templates on pages 4, 5 and 6 onto heavy template material. (Print template pages with no margins)

2. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 8 - 10 1/4" x 14 1/2" (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - cut 1 - 11 1/2" x 15 1/2"

cut 2 - 11 3/4" strips, subcut 4 - 11 3/4" x 16", cut in half diagonally - 2  , 2 

Fabric E - Outer Border - cut 8 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut: 2 - 2 1/2" x 77 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 2 1/2" x 61 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric F - BINDING - cut 8 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric G - INNER BORDER - cut 7 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 57 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric J - **cut 4 - 1 1/8" strips, subcut 8 - 1 1/8" x 14 1/2" (Sides)

**cut 3 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 11 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric K - **cut 4 - 1 1/8" strips, subcut 8 - 1 1/8" x 14 1/2" (Sides)

**cut 3 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 11 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

3. Use the prepared **TEMPLATES** and cut the following by placing arrows over grainline of fabric. "R" means to reverse the template by turning over.

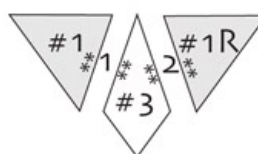

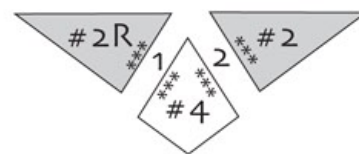

4. Piecing Order:

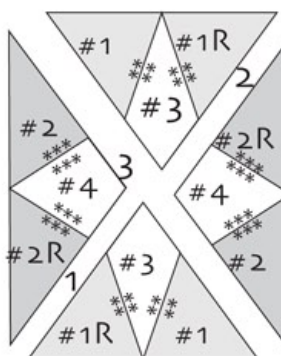
2. Make 8 - 11" x 15" finished (11 1/2" x 15 1/2" unf.) star blocks. First, sew template #1 and #1 Reverse to both sides of template #3. Then sew template #2 and #2 Reverse to both sides of template #4. Next, sew sections together for 8 large blocks according to the diagrams. Pay special attention to the fabrics since all blocks are not identical.



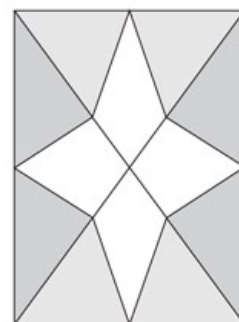

2. Sew **J** borders around 4 **A** red blocks and sew **K** borders around 4 **A** green blocks, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram. ** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **J** and **K** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** blocks, then trim all **A** blocks to measure $11\frac{1}{2}" \times 15\frac{1}{2}"$.)



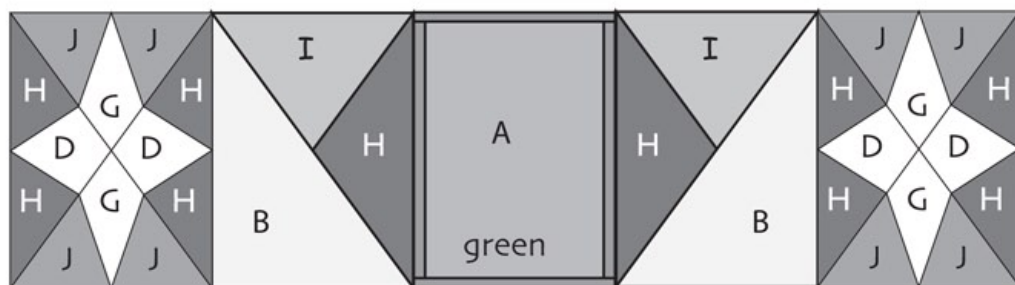
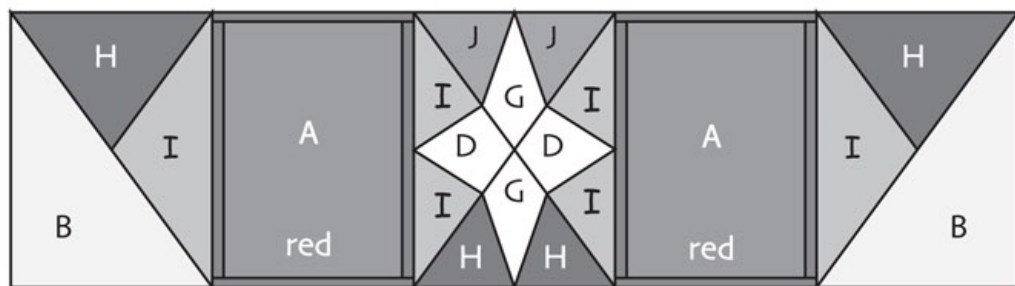
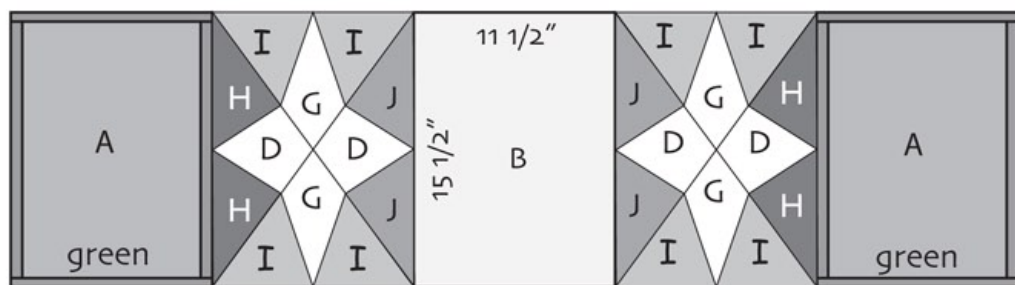
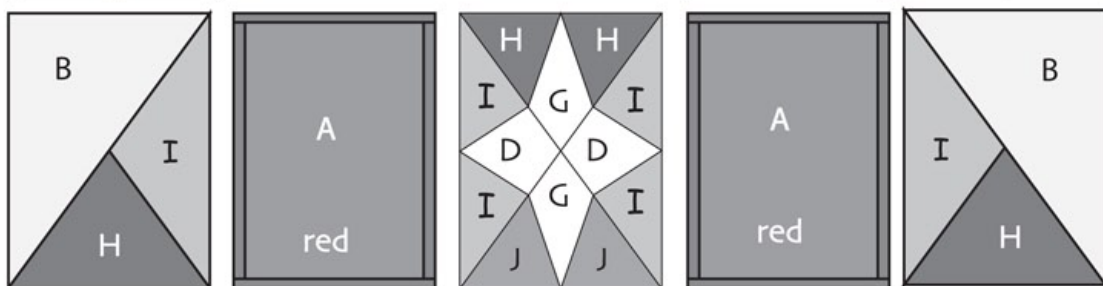
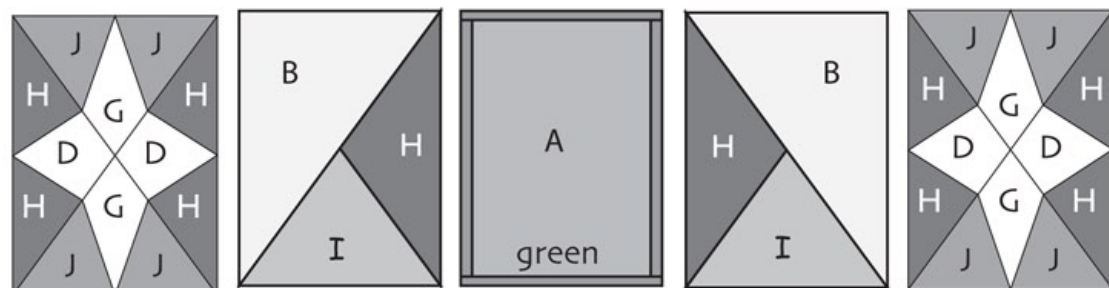
3. Make 8 - $11" \times 15"$ finished ($11\frac{1}{2}" \times 15\frac{1}{2}"$ unf.) connector blocks. First, sew template #5 and #6 together, then sew section to large **B** triangles according to the diagram. Pay special attention to the fabrics according to the diagrams since all blocks are not identical.



4. Sew quilt center together by rows of blocks according to the diagram on the next page.
5. Sew **G** $1\frac{1}{2}"$ borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.
6. Sew **E** $2\frac{1}{2}"$ borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.
7. The quilt measures approximately $61" \times 81"$. Make backing (**Fabric C**) at least $6"$ larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!
