Yardages

HOCO 143 D (Panel Print):

1 panel (2 blocks)

HOCO 145 G (Green Print):

1/3 yard

HOCO 145 N (Navy Print):

3/8 yard

HOCO 146 Z (Brown Print):

1/8 yard

HOCO 148 D (Red Floral):

1/4 yard

HOCO 148 X (Gold Floral):

1/8 yard

HOCO 149 D (Red Tonal):

1/8 yard

HOCO 149 X (Gold Tonal):

1/3 yard

CSNE-W (White Solid):

1 1/8 yards

BACKING:

2 5/8 yards of any *Homecoming* (or white solid) fabric

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

Panel, cut:

- (1) 15 1/4" A square (diagonal flower)
- (1) 16 1/4" B square (wreath)

Gold Tonal, cut:

- (16) 3 1/2" squares

Green Print, cut:

- (16) 3 1/2" squares

Red Tonal, cut:

- (4) 3 1/8" squares

Navy Print, cut:

- (12) 5 3/4" squares

Gold Floral, cut:

- (8) 3 1/8" squares

Brown Print, cut:

- (8) 3 1/8" squares

Red Floral, cut:

- (4) 5 3/4" squares

White Solid, cut:

- (8) 5" squares; cut twice diagonally to yield 32 quarter-square triangles
- (2) 4 5/8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles
- (4) 3" x wof border strips
- (5) 2 1/4" x wof binding strips



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Assembly

1. Cut the B panel square twice diagonally to make four triangles. Join the triangles to the A panel square to make the center square, referring to the photo as needed. Trim the center square to measure 21 1/2" x 21 1/2"
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the gold tonal squares. Pair a marked square right sides together with a green squares. Sew 1/4" from each side of the drawn line. Cut the squares apart on the drawn line and press the seam allowances toward the green triangles. Trim the triangle squares to 3 1/8" x 3 1/8", as needed.
3. Join eight triangle squares from step 2 to make a border strip as shown in the photo. Make four strips. Sew two strips to opposite sides of the center square. Add a red tonal square to each end of the two remaining strips and sew them to the center square.
4. Sew white quarter-square triangles to adjacent sides of a brown square to make a setting unit. Make eight brown units. Repeat using the gold floral squares to make eight gold units.



5. Sew gold units to opposite sides of a navy square as shown in the assembly diagram. Press the seam allowances toward the navy square. Make four of these units.

6. Sew a navy square to opposite sides of a red floral square and then sew brown units from step 4 to each end as shown in the assembly diagram. Make four units.

7. Join the units from steps 5 and 6 in pairs and then add a white corner triangle to the top of the navy square to make a corner unit.

8. Join the corner units to the center unit as shown.



9. Measure the length of the quilt top through the center and trim two white 3"-wide strips to this length. Sew the strip to the sides of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top (including the just-added borders) and trim two white 3"-wide strips to this length. Sew the strip to the quilt top.

10. Layer the wall hanging with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired and bind the edges to finish.
