


Critter Christmas

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Wall Hanging Instructions: approximate size 48" x 68 1/2"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 1 - 29 1/2'' x 42 1/2'' (center design evenly) Fabric B - cut borders lengthwise: cut 2 - 10 1/4'' x 43 1/2''(TOP and BOTTOM) and 2 - 2 3/4'' x 68 1/2'' (Sides) according to the cutting diagram of the fabric



Fabric F - cut 3 - 5 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip then subcut 2 - 5 1/2" x 44 1/2" (Sides) cut 3 - 1 3/4" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip then subcut 2 - 1 3/4" x 41 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric G - BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half


Fabric I - cut 4 - 11/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 11/2" x 421/2" (Sides) and 2 - 11/2" x 311/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric L - cut 5 - 11/2" strips sew end to end then subcut 2 - 11/2" x 47" (Sides) and 2 - 11/2" 43 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

2. Piecing Order:

- 1. First, sew I 1 1/2" borders around A center block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.
- Next, sew F 5 1/2" x 44 1/2" borders to the SIDES of the Wall Hanging. Then sew F 1 3/4" x 41 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.
- 3. Sew **L** 1 1/2" borders around the Wall Hanging, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

4. Sew **B** 10 $1/4'' \times 43 1/2''$ borders to the TOP and BOTTOM of the Wall hanging. Then sew **B** $2 3/4'' \times 68 1/2''$ to both SIDES according to the diagram.



5. The Wall Hanging measures approximately 48" x 68 1/2". Make backing (**Fabric D**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

Pillow #1 Instructions: approximate size 17" x 17"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric G - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 1 1/2" squares and 8 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric H - cut 1 - 1 1/2" strip, subcut 20 - 1 1/2" squares
Fabric I - cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 3 7/8" squares
cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 9 - 3 1/2" squares and
4 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

Fabric M - Borders - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut
2 - 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 17 1/2"

BACKING - cut 1 - 12 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 12 1/2" x 17 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

1. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 4 I 3 7/8" squares. Pair I and G squares right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press to the darker fabric for 8 G/I units.










 Make 4 - 3" finished (3 1/2")
 9-patches by sewing G and H 1 1/2" squares together by rows according to the diagram.







3. Make 4 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) rail blocks by sewing **G** and **I** 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles together according to the diagram.




4. Next, sew block together by rows according to the diagram. Then, sew **M** 1 1/2" borders around the block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.





5. Backing: double fold 1/4" then topstitch one side of both **M** backing pieces. Overlap backing pieces and place over pillow block, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" around pillow edge. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Insert 18" pillow form and enjoy!!





Pillow #2 Instructions: approximate size 17" x 17"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric G - cut 1 - 1 1/2" strip, subcut 20 - 1 1/2" squares
Fabric H - cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 9 - 3 1/2" squares
and 4 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric J - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 1 1/2" squares and 8 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric M - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 17 1/2"

BACKING - cut 1 - 12 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 12 1/2" x 17 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

 First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 4 H 3 7/8" squares. Pair H and J squares right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press to the darker fabric for 8 J/H units.












Make 4 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.)
 9-patches by sewing G and J 1 1/2" squares together by rows according to the diagram.




3. Make 4 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) rail blocks by sewing **J** and **H** 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles together according to the diagram.



4. Next, sew block together by rows according to the diagram. Then, sew **M** 1 1/2" borders around the block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.





(see step 5 above for making backing and finishing pillow)

Pillow #3 Instructions: approximate size 16" x 24" Page Three

Cut the following:

Fabric C - cut 1 - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square (center design evenly)

Backing cut 1 - 16 1/2" x 24 1/2"

Fabric E - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

cut 2 - 5 7/8'' squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles \square

Fabric K - cut 1 - 5 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 5 1/2" x 10 1/2"
(Top and Bottom)


cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric L - cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 24 1/2"


cut 2 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles

2. Piecing Order:


 Sew L triangles around center square C, opposite side first. Center triangles evenly by folding triangles and square in half then match middle marks.




Next, sew E triangles to all sides of center square, opposite sides first. Center triangles evenly.



3. Sew **K** 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" to both sides of center square, then sew **K** 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" to the top and bottom according to the diagram.



4. Next, sew **E** 1 1/2" borders around the pillow, sides first, then top and bottom borders. Then sew **L** 1 1/2" borders, sides first, then top and bottom borders.



5. Place backing (**Fabric C**) over pillow top, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" around edge, leaving approximately 6" opening for turning. Clip corners and turn pillow right sides out. Stuff with fiberfill. Stitch opening closed and enjoy!!
