

## Critter Christmas

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## Wall Hanging Instructions: approximate size $48^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 1-29 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (center design evenly) Fabric B - cut borders lengthwise: cut 2-10 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (TOP and BOTTOM) and $2-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Sides) according to the cutting diagram of the fabric


Fabric F - cut 3-5 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip then subcut 2-51/2" $\times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Sides) cut 3-1 3/4" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip then subcut 2-1 3/4" $\times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Top and Bottom)
Fabric G-BINDING - cut 6-2 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew end to end and press in half
Fabric I - cut 4-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew end to end then subcut 2-11/2" $\times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Sides) and 2-11/2" $\times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Top and Bottom)
Fabric L-cut 5-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips sew end to end then subcut 2-11/2" $\times 47^{\prime \prime}$ (Sides) and 2-11/2" $431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(Top and Bottom)

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. First, sew $I_{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders around $\mathbf{A}$ center block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.
2. Next, sew F $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the SIDES of the Wall Hanging. Then sew F $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.
3. Sew $\mathrm{L}_{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders around the Wall Hanging, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.
4. Sew B $101 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the TOP and BOTTOM of the Wall hanging. Then sew B $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to both SIDES according to the diagram.

5. The Wall Hanging measures approximately $48^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make backing (Fabric D) at least $6^{\prime \prime}$ larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!

## Pillow \#1 Instructions: approximate size $17^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{\prime \prime}$

## 1. Cut the following:

Fabric G-cut 2-11/2" strips, subcut 16-11/2" squares and $8-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles cut 1-37/8" strip, subcut 4-37/8" squares
Fabric H-cut 1-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut $20-11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric I - cut 1-37/8" strip, subcut 4-37/8" squares cut 1-3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut $9-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and 4-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Fabric $M$ - Borders - cut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut
2-11/2" $\times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
BACKING - cut 1-12 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut 2-12 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 4 I $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Pair I and G squares right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press to the darker fabric for $8 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{I}$ units.

2. Make $4-3^{\prime \prime}$ finished (3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) 9 -patches by sewing $G$ and H 1 1/2" squares together by rows according to the diagram.
3. Make 4- $3^{\prime \prime}$ finished ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unf.) rail blocks by sewing G and I $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ 1/2" rectangles together according to the diagram.

4. Next, sew block together by rows according to the diagram. Then, sew M 1 1/2" borders around the block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.

5. Backing: double fold $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ then topstitch one side of both $\boldsymbol{M}$ backing pieces. Overlap backing pieces and place over pillow block, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ around pillow edge. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Insert 18" pillow form and enjoy!!


## Pillow \#2 Instructions: approximate size $17^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{\prime \prime}$

## 1. Cut the following:

Fabric G - cut 1-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut 20-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric H-cut 1-3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut $9-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
and 4-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
cut 1-37/8" strip, subcut 4-37/8" squares
Fabric J-cut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut 16-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
and 8-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles cut $1-37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut $4-37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric $M$ - cut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 2-1 1/2" $\times 17$ 1/2"

BACKING - cut 1-12 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut 2-12 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of $4 \mathrm{H}_{3} 7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Pair H and J squares right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press to the darker fabric for $8 \mathrm{~J} / \mathrm{H}$ units. J


2. Make 4- $3^{\prime \prime}$ finished ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unf.) 9-patches by sewing G and J 1 1/2" squares together by rows according to the diagram.

3. Make 4- $3^{\prime \prime}$ finished (3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unf.) rail blocks by sewing J and H $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ 1/2" rectangles together according to the diagram.

4. Next, sew block together by rows according to the diagram. Then, sew M 1 1/2" borders around the block, sides first, then top and bottom borders.


Pillow \#3 Instructions: approximate size $16^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ Page Three

## 1. Cut the following:

Fabric C - cut 1-5 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (center design evenly)

Backing cut 1-16 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric E-cut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 2-11/2" $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
cut 2-5 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles
Fabric K - cut 1-5 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, subcut 2-5 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Top and Bottom)
cut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut 2-11/2" $\times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Top and Bottom)
Fabric L-cut 3-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
cut 2-4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles $\mathbb{N}$

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew L triangles around center square C, opposite side first. Center triangles evenly by folding triangles and square in half then match middle marks.

2. Next, sew E triangles to all sides of center square, opposite sides first. Center triangles evenly.

3. Sew K $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to both sides of center square, then sew K $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the top and bottom according to the diagram.

4. Next, sew E $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders around the pillow, sides first, then top and bottom borders. Then sew $\mathrm{L} 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders, sides first, then top and bottom borders.

5. Place backing (Fabric C) over pillow top, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ around edge, leaving approximately 6 " opening for turning. Clip corners and turn pillow right sides out. Stuff with fiberfill. Stitch opening closed and enjoy!!
