## Toys...Toys...Toys

Designed by Terry Perry using her *Toys...Toys...Toys* collection for Northcott.  
Use either the cottons or the flannels (F).

**Skill level:** Advanced beginner

**Quilt Size:** 73" x 91"

**Number of Blocks & Finished Size:** (24) 5" half-square triangle blocks, (6) 10" framed toy blocks & (4) 7" corner blocks

Note: Yardage and instructions based on unwashed fabric. Please do not pre-wash these fabrics.

<b>Fabric Requirements</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Yds</b>	<b>Cutting</b>
Fabric A (F)#3108-12	panel	1yd	Trim panel to 43" x 35"
Fabric B (F)#3118-99	trees/black	1¼yds	Cut 4 strips 3¼" x width of fabric (wof); trim 2 to 43" and 2 to 40½" (1 <sup>st</sup> border). Cut 9 strips 2¼" x wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding. Cut (3) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric C (F)#3111-12	tossed toys	1¼yds	Cut 4 lengthwise strips 10½" wide; trim 2 to 40½". Cut the balance into (4) 19½" pieces. (2 <sup>nd</sup> border)
Fabric D (F)#3109-12	8" squares	¾yd*	*You will need 3 full rows of blocks. Cut (4) 6½" blue/black snowmen face squares, centering a motif in each square (outer border). *See note below. Cut (6) 7½" toys squares, centering a motif in each square.
Fabric E (F)#3115-79	dots/green	⅝yd	Cut 6 strips 2" x wof; cut each strip into (2) 10½" pieces and (2) 7½" pieces (2 <sup>nd</sup> border). Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric F (F)#3112-43	blue snowmen	fat ⅞	Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric G (F)#3114-26	toys/wine dots	fat ⅞	Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric H (F)#3115-26	dots/wine	fat ⅞	Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric I (F)#3115-30	dots/cream	fat ⅞	Cut (3) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric J (F)#3115-44	dots/blue	fat ⅞	Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric K (F)#3116-26	snowflakes/wine	fat ⅞	Cut (2) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric L (F)#3116-79	snowflake/green	fat ⅞	Cut (3) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric M (F)#3119-26	wine/green stripe	fat ⅞	Cut (3) 5⅞" squares; cut once diagonally.
Fabric N (F)#3110-12	lengthwise stripe	2¾yd	Cut 3 lengthwise strips 7½" wide, centering the bear and tree stripes in each strip. Join end-to-end and cut (2) 78½" pieces and (2) 60½" pieces.
Fabric O (F)#3117-26	check	⅞yd	Cut 3 strips 1" x wof; cut into (8) 7½" pieces and (8) 6½" pieces (to frame corner blocks).
Backing (F)#3113-12	tossed elves	5½yds	Cut into 2 equal pieces and join selvedge-to-selvedge.
Batting	A piece 78" x 96"		

\*Note: If you wish, cut these snowmen blocks 7" high, fold the piece in half horizontally and sew ¼" from fold to make a 6½" square without cutting off the heads of the snowmen.

### Piecing:

1. 1<sup>st</sup> border (2¾"): Sew a 43" Fabric B piece to each side of Fabric A panel, and a 40½" Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges of panel, pressing seam toward B.
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> border (10"): Sew a 7½" Fabric E piece to each side of the (6) 7½" Fabric D squares, then sew a 10½" Fabric E piece to top and bottom edges, pressing seam toward E.
3. Sew a 19½" Fabric C piece to top and bottom edges of 2 framed blocks, pressing seam toward block. Sew to sides of quilt.
4. Sew a framed square to each end of the 40½" Fabric C pieces, pressing seam toward block, and add to top and bottom edges of quilt.
5. Pieced rows (5"): Randomly sew the 5⅞" triangles together along long edges to make 24 blocks.
6. Sew the blocks together into 2 rows of 12 blocks each. Press and sew to top and bottom edges of quilt.
7. Outer border (7"): Sew a 60½" Fabric N piece to top and bottom edges of quilt, with bears at inner edge.
8. Sew a 6½" Fabric O piece to each side of the 6½" snowmen blocks, then sew a 7½" Fabric O piece to top and bottom edges, pressing seam toward O.
9. Sew a framed snowmen block to each end of a 72½" Fabric N piece, and add to sides of quilt.

### Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared Fabric B binding to the edges, turn and stitch in place.
