Skill level: Advanced beginner
Quilt Size: 73" x 91"
Number of Blocks \& Finished Size: (24) 5" half-square triangle blocks, (6) 10" framed toy blocks \& (4) 7" corner blocks
Note: Yardage and instructions based on unwashed fabric. Please do not pre-wash these fabrics.

| Fabric Requirements | Description | Yds | Cutting |

| Fabric A (F)\#3108-12 | panel | 1yd | Trim panel to 43" $\times 35$ " |
| Fabric B (F)\#3118-99 | trees/black | 11/4yds | Cut 4 strips $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (wof); trim 2 to $43^{\prime \prime}$ and 2 to $401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( $1^{\text {st }}$ border). <br> Cut 9 strips $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding. <br> Cut (3) $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric C (F)\#3111-12 | tossed toys | 11/4yds | Cut 4 lengthwise strips $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide; trim 2 to $40^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime} .}$. Cut the balance into (4) $1912^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ border) |
| Fabric D (F)\#3109-12 | 8" squares | 2/3yd* | *You will need 3 full rows of blocks. Cut (4) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue/black snowmen face squares, centering a motif in each square (outer border).* *ee note below. Cut (6) $71 / 2$ " toys squares, centering a motif in each square. |
| Fabric E (F)\#3115-79 | dots/green | 5/8yd | Cut 6 strips $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; cut each strip into (2) $10^{1 / 2 "}$ pieces and (2) $71 / 2$ " pieces ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ border). <br> Cut (2) $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric F (F)\#3112-43 | blue snowmen | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (2) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric G (F)\#3114-26 | toys/wine dots | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (2) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric H (F)\#3115-26 | dots/wine | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (2) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric I (F)\#3115-30 | dots/cream | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (3) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric J (F)\#3115-44 | dots/blue | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (2) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric K (F)\#3116-26 | snowflakes/wine | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (2) $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric L (F)\#3116-79 | snowflake/green | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (3) $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric M (F)\#3119-26 | wine/green stripe | fat $1 / 8$ | Cut (3) $57 / 8$ " squares; cut once diagonally. |
| Fabric N (F)\#3110-12 | lengthwise stripe | 23/4yd | Cut 3 lengthwise strips $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, centering the bear and tree stripes in each strip. Join end-to-end and cut (2) $781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and (2) $60 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. |
| Fabric O (F)\#3117-26 | check | 1/8yd | Cut 3 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; cut into (8) $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and (8) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (to frame corner blocks). |
| Backing (F)\#3113-12 | tossed elves | 51/2yds | Cut into 2 equal pieces and join selvedge-to-selvedge. |
| Batting | A piece 78" $\times 96$ |  |  |

*Note: If you wish, cut these snowmen blocks 7 " high, fold the piece in half horizontally and sew $1 / 4$ " from fold to make a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square without cutting off the heads of the snowmen.

## Piecing:

1. $1^{\text {st }}$ border ( $23 / 4$ "): Sew a 43 " Fabric B piece to each side of Fabric A panel, and a $401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges of panel, pressing seam toward $B$.
2. $2^{\text {nd }}$ border ( 10 "): Sew a $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E piece to each side of the (6) $71 / 2$ " Fabric D squares, then sew a $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E piece to top and bottom edges, pressing seam toward $E$.
3. Sew a $191 / 2$ " Fabric C piece to top and bottom edges of 2 framed blocks, pressing seam toward block. Sew to sides of quilt.
4. Sew a framed square to each end of the $401 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " Fabric $C$ pieces, pressing seam toward block, and add to top and bottom edges of quilt.
5. Pieced rows ( 5 "): Randomly sew the $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles together along long edges to make 24 blocks.
6. Sew the blocks together into 2 rows of 12 blocks each. Press and sew to top and bottom edges of quilt.
7. Outer border (7"): Sew a $601 / 2$ " Fabric $N$ piece to top and bottom edges of quilt, with bears at inner edge.
8. Sew a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric O piece to each side of the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ snowmen blocks, then sew a $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric O piece to top and bottom edges, pressing seam toward $O$.
9. Sew a framed snowmen block to each end of a $721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $N$ piece, and add to sides of quilt.

## Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared Fabric $B$ binding to the edges, turn and stitch in place.
