

### **Materials**

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

3/4 yd Running Blocks (Y0493-36)

1 yd Stripe (Y0494-36) 1/8 yd Green Tonal(Y0495-18) 3/8 yd Purple Tonal(Y0495-27)

(includes binding)

1/4 yd Purple Witch Toss(Y0496-27)1 yd Purple Med. Toss(Y0497-27)

(includes backing)

1/4 yd Gold Small Toss(Y0580-9) 3/4 yd Purple Small Toss(Y0580-27)

1 yd fusible web

# **Cut the Fabrics**

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

#### From the Running Blocks cut:

7 – fussy cut framed pictures around edges of outside solid color frames

#### From the Stripe cut:

 $2 - 5-1/2'' \times 32-1/2''$  border strips fussy cut to include patterns as indicated in the guilt photo.

#### From the Green Tonal cut:

7 - 2 - 1/2" squares

#### From the Purple Tonal cut:

4 - 2 - 1/2'' squares

4-2-1/4" x WOF strips and sew together end-to-end for binding

# From the Purple Witch Toss cut:

18 - 2 - 1/2'' squares

#### From the Purple Medium Toss cut:

1 – 35" x 38" piece for quilt backing

3 - 2 - 1/2'' squares for border squares

#### From the Gold Small Toss cut:

3 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips, recut into: 36 - 2-1/2" squares

# From the Purple Small Toss cut:

 $1 - 20-1/2" \times 24-1/2"$  (center background)

4 - 2-1/2" squares

# **Directions**

# Prior to starting this project, please check our web site for any updates: www.clothworkstextiles.com. Making the Quilt

- Refer to the vertical border diagrams for right and left borders, piece 3 strips of (12) 2-1/2" squares, alternating the various print 2-1/2" squares with the Gold Small Toss 2-1/2" squares in a checkerboard style. Sew the strips together. Make 2 borders. Sew these borders to the opposite long sides of the center purple stars panel
- 2. Sew the fussy cut stripe borders to the top and bottom of the center rectangle.
- 3. Following the manufacturer's directions for the fusible web adhere the 7 pictures that were fussy cut from the Running Blocks print to the Purple Small Toss quilt center background rectangle. Note that some of the pictures overlap slightly onto the borders and overlap each other. Refer to the quilt photo for picture placement.

#### Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Layer quilt with batting and backing. Quilt 1/8" inside the frame of each of the 7 fussy cut pictures that have been fused to the quilt center to hold them in place. Quilt in the ditch around the seam lines of the pieced border squares. Quilt in straight lines on the top and bottom border following the stripes in the border print. Option: outline quilt around the figures in each picture.
- 2. Fold the binding in half lengthwise (wrong sides together) and press the fold line. Pin the raw edges of the folded binding to the raw edges of the quilt top and stitch in place. Turn the folded edge to the back of the quilt and stitch in place.
