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

	С	Diagonal Word Stripe 3488-75 Taupe/Red	1/2 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. (2) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips. (16) FUSSY CUT 3-1/2" squares.
	D	Winter Wishes Dots 3489-10 <i>Red</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. (2) 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips.

	F	Winter Plaid 3484-75 <i>Taupe/Red</i>	1/3 YD	(4) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. (4) 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips.
* * * * *	G	Snowflakes 3486-71 <i>Taupe</i>	1/2 YD	(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut into (72) 2-1/2" squares.

*TIP: MAKE A 7" TEMPLATE/GUIDE TO CUT BLOCKS, SINCE THEY'RE NOT SQUARES.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. BLOCK ONE: For BLOCK ONE assembly see QUILT DIAGRAM. Take (1) E 1-1/2" x 7" strip and sew to each side of (1) A 7" block. Repeat for top and bottom using (1) E 1-1/2" x 9" strip. Square block to 8-1/2". Make 5 BLOCK ONES.



2. BLOCK Two: Sew (4) **C** 3-1/2" squares into a 6-1/2" square, *note direction of C's diagonal stripe.* Then add (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of **C** block. Repeat for bottom and top using **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Square to 8-1/2". Make 4 Block Twos.



- **4. Sashing Strip:** Take (2) **B** and **G** 2-1/2" squares and sew together, alternating them, starting with **B**.
- **5. Sashing Row:** Sew (8) **B** and (8) **G** 2-1/2" squares together, alternating them, starting with **B** square. Refer to diagram below. Make 6 SASHING ROWS.




QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Take blocks one and two, sashing strips and sashing rows and sew them together as shown in *Quilt Diagram*. *Note rotation of sashing strips and sashing rows*.

BORDER ASSEMBLY Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for reference.

7. Take (1) **D** and (2) **F** 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip and sew them together (see diagram below). Make 2 **CDF** border strips.




- **8.** Sew CDF strips to each side of quilt top, with D fabric on the inside.
- **9.** Repeat step 7 using **CDF** 32-1/2" strips. Make 2. Add (1) **B** 5-1/2" square to each end of **CDF** strips. Then sew **CDF-B** strips to top and bottom of quilt top, with **D** on the inside, as shown in *QUILT DIAGRAM*.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Make quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
