### Winter Whispers

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

# Project 1 Eagle Quilt Instructions: approximate size 44" x 56"

1. Cut the following for the EAGLE Quilt:

Fabric A - cut 1 - 28 1/2" x 41 1/2" (center design evenly)
Fabric E - cut 4 - 4 3/4" strips, subcut 20 - 4 3/4" squares
and 4 - 4 3/4" x 9" rectangles

Fabric H - cut 2 - 7 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 24 small triangles ⊠

Fabric L - Borders - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 41 1/2" (Sides) cut 2 - 1" x 30 1/2" (Top and Bottom) BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and

press in half

Fabric M - cut 2 - 7 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 24 small


triangles acut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally

Fabric N - Borders - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" (Top and Bottom)


### Piecing Order:


for 4 corner triangles

 Sew L borders around center panel A, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.




 Make units for the pieced border by sewing H and M triangles to E squares according to the diagrams. Arrows indicate pressing directions.













3. Sew three #1 units and one #2 unit together for BOTH top and bottom borders. Sew five #1 units and one #2 unit together for BOTH side borders according to the diagram.



- 4. Sew SIDE borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Last, sew corner unit #3 to each corner.
- 5. Sew **N** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

6. The Eagle Quilt measures approximately 44" x 56". Make backing (**Fabric G**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric L**) and enjoy!!

### Project 2 **RABBIT Quilt Instructions:** approximate size 38" x 38"

Cut the following for the RABBIT Quilt:

Fabric D - cut 1 - 19" x 23 1/2" (center design evenly) Fabric F - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ⊠

**Fabric H** - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles X

Fabric I - cut  $2 - 13/4'' \times 231/2''$  (Top and Bottom borders) cut 2 - 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for corner triangles  $(1- \square, 1- \square)$ 

Fabric K - cut 2 - 1" x 21 1/2" (Sides)

cut 2 - 2" x 24 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" (Sides)

and cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for corner triangles (1 - N , 1 - N )


BINDING - cut 4 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric M - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles 🛛

Fabric N - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ⊠

#### Piecing Order:

 Sew I 1 3/4" x 23 1/2" borders above and below D RABBIT center block. Next, sew K borders around center block, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



2. Make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) quarter square triangle units. First, sew 16 pairs of F and H triangles together, press toward H. Sew 16 pairs of M and N triangles together, press toward M. Then sew pairs together according to the diagram.

3. Make 4 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) half square triangle units for corner blocks by sewing K and I large triangles together. Press toward K. (Both fabrics are directional so refer to the colored cover picture for exact placement.)




4. Make two SIDE borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together according to the diagram.




make 2 - SIDES

5. Make the TOP and BOTTOM by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together for each border. Then sew a half square triangle unit to both ends according to the diagrams.



6. Sew SIDE pieced borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Next, sew K 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.

7. The RABBIT quilt measures approximately 38" x 38". Baste together top, batting and backing (Fabric G). Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric K) and enjoy!!

### Project 2 FOREST Quilt Instructions: approximate size 38" x 38"

1. Cut the following for the FOREST Quilt:

Fabric D - cut 1 - 19" x 23 1/2" (center design evenly)
Fabric E - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares,
cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for
16 triangles ⊠

cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles  $\square$ 

Fabric F - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ⊠

cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles  $\square$ 

cut 2 - 1" x 19" (Sides)

cut 2 - 3 1/4" x 24 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" (Top and Bottom)


Fabric G - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ⊠

Fabric H - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ⊠

BINDING - cut 4 - 21/4'' strips, sew end to end and press in half

#### 2. Piecing Order:

Sew F 1" x 19" borders to both SIDES of D
FOREST center block. Next, sew F 3 1/4" x 24 1/2" to
the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.



2. Make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) quarter square triangle units. First, sew 16 pairs of F and H triangles together, press toward H. Sew 16 pairs of E and G triangles together, press toward G. Then sew pairs together according to the diagram.










3. Make 4 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) half square triangle units for corner blocks by sewing E and F large triangles together. Press toward F.



4. Make two SIDE borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together according to the diagram.



make 2 - SIDES

Make the TOP and BOTTOM borders by sewing 4
quarter square triangle units together for each border.
 Then sew a half square triangle unit to each end
according to the diagram.



6. Sew SIDE pieced borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Next, sew **F** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



7. The FOREST quilt measures approximately 38" x 38". Baste together top, batting and backing (**Fabric G**). Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric L**) and enjoy!!

## Project 3 BIRD Quilt Instructions: approximate size 38" x 38"

1. Cut the following for the BIRD Quilt:

Fabric C - cut 1 - 19" x 23 1/2" (center design evenly)

Fabric E, F, H and M - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut

4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles of each fabric 

Fabric J - cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles 

cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2"

(Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric L - cut 2 - 1" x 19" (Sides)

cut 2 - 3 1/4" x 24 1/2" (Top and Bottom)


cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles (1 - M , 1 - M)

BINDING - cut 4 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and

press in half

Sew L 1" x 19" borders to both SIDES of C
BIRD center block. Next, sew L 3 1/2" x 24 1/2" to
the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.



 Make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) quarter square triangle units. First, sew 16 pairs of F and H triangles together, press toward H. Sew 16 pairs of E and M triangles together, press toward M. Then sew pairs together according to the diagram.

3. Make 4 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) half square triangle units for corner blocks by sewing J and L large triangles together. Press toward L.




4. Make two SIDE borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together according to the diagram.





5. Make the TOP and BOTTOM borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together for each border. Then sew a half square triangle unit to each end according to the diagram.

6. Sew SIDE pieced borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Next, sew J 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



7. The BIRD quilt measures approximately 38" x 38". Baste together top, batting and backing (Fabric G). Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric L) and enjoy!!

### Project 3 **RIVER Quilt Instructions:** approximate size 38" x 38"

1. Cut the following for the RIVER Quilt:

Fabric C - cut 1 - 19" x 23 1/2" (center design evenly) Fabric E - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles 🖂

cut  $2 - 67/8'' \times 67/8''$  squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles \square

Fabric F - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles

cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles \

cut 4 - 11/2" strips, subcut 2 - 11/2" x 36 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric H - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles 🛛


Fabric L - cut 2 - 1" x 19" (Sides)

cut 2 - 3 1/4" x 24 1/2" (Top and Bottom) BINDING - cut 4 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric M - cut 1 - 7 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles 🖂

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew L 1" x 19" borders to both SIDES of C RIVER center block. Next, sew L 3 1/4" x 24 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM according to the diagram.

2. Make 16 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) quarter square triangle units. First, sew 16 pairs of F and H triangles together, press toward H. Sew 16 pairs of E and M triangles together, press toward M. Then sew pairs together according to the diagram.





3. Make 4 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) half square triangle units for corner blocks by sewing E and F large triangles together. Press toward F.




4. Make two SIDE borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together according to the diagram.



5. Make the TOP and BOTTOM borders by sewing 4 quarter square triangle units together for each border. Then sew a half square triangle unit to both ends according to the diagrams.



6. Sew SIDE pieced borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Next, sew F 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



7. The RIVER quilt measures approximately 38" x 38". Baste together top, batting and backing (Fabric G). Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric L) and enjoy!!

## Project 4 DEER Quilt Instructions: approximate size 44" x 56"

1. Cut the following for the DEER Quilt:

Fabric B - cut 1 - 28 1/2" x 41 1/2" (center design evenly)
Fabric G - cut 2 - 7 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 7 1/4" squares,
cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for
24 small triangles

**Fabric H** - cut 4 - 4 3/4" strips, subcut 20 - 4 3/4" squares, and 4 - 4 3/4" x 9" rectangles

Fabric I - cut 2 - 7 1/4" strips, subcut 6 - 7 1/4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions for 24 small triangles  $\boxtimes$ 

BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half


Fabric K - Inner Border - cut 2 - 1" x 28 1/2" (Sides) and cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

cut 2 - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles  $(1 - \mathbb{N} \ , 1 - \mathbb{N})$ 


Outer Border - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" (Top and Bottom)


### 2. Piecing Order:

 Sew K borders around center panel B, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.




2. Make units for the pieced border by sewing **G** and **I** triangles to **H** squares according to the diagrams.






(arrows indicate pressing direction)

3. Sew three #1 units and one #2 unit together for BOTH top and bottom borders. Sew five #1 units and one #2 unit together for BOTH side borders according to the diagram.



- Sew SIDE borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. Last, sew corner unit #3 to each corner.
- 5. Sew **K** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



6. The Deer Quilt measures approximately 44" x 56".
Make backing (Fabric G) at least 6" larger than the top.
Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
Attach binding (Fabric I) and enjoy!!
